The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

IN RE: RULES OF THE JUDICIAL QUALIFICATIONS
COMMISSION OF GEORGIA

For the duration of the statewide judicial emergency declared by the Chief Justice on March 14, 2020, and any modifications and extensions thereof, the following provisions of the Rules of the Judicial Qualifications Commission of Georgia are hereby clarified and/or amended as follows:

Rules 3 (A) and 17 (C) (5) are amended to the extent that they require members of the Investigative Panel to be present in person for a panel meeting with a judge pursuant to Rule 17 (C) (4). At the discretion of the chairperson of the Investigative Panel, such meetings may be attended by the judge, members, and JQC staff remotely using video technology.

Rule 3 (C) is clarified and/or amended to the extent that it could be read to require members of the Investigative Panel to be present in person for purposes of establishing a quorum. A quorum for meetings may be established by the attendance of members remotely by conference call or remotely using video technology.
